Dear Registered Public Accountant,

**Fee for Annual Practising Certificate for 2026.**

The fee for the year 2026 is Sixty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$69,000).

This fee is now due and should be remitted to the Public Accountancy Board (PAB) as soon as possible.

Please note the provisions of Section 14 A (1) and (2) of the Public Accountancy Act which read as follows:

- (1) A person registered under the Act shall not practise as a public accountant except by virtue of and in accordance with a Practising Certificate which shall be issued by the Board in the prescribed form on payment to the Board of the prescribed annual fee;
- (2) A person who practises in contravention of subsection (1) shall be incapable of maintaining any action for recovery of any fee or reward on account of, or in relation to, any act done by him in the course of such practice.

Please complete and return, with your remittance, the attached documents:

- (a) Form for Renewal of a Practising Certificate for 2026
- (b) 2026 Questionnaire for Risk Based Approach (required for Financial Action Task Force (FATF) purposes).

**The Practising Certificate will not be issued unless both the Form and the Questionnaire are received by the PAB.**
